UCP CRITERIA & ASSESSMENTS

Requirements:

1. Must currently reside and will continue to reside in Utah County, the entire probation term.
2. Cannot currently be on probation with AP&P or another 3rd party.
3. Current case contains drug and/or alcohol charges, **or**
4. Established criminal history of substance use and/or abuse.

Disqualifiers:

1. Any current or past incident, with/without charges, or convictions of the following:
 - a. Offense against an officer.
 - b. Aggravated felony against a person or animal.
2. Specific types of incidents, will require further UCP review, related to:
 - a. Sex offense
 - b. Weapons offense

Assessments:

1. Referrals to UCP must come from the prosecutor and/or the presiding judge.
 - a. Please provide the defendants name and case number to begin the process.
 - b. Referrals can be emailed to probation@utahcounty.gov or call our office at 801-851-4041
2. Assessments can be performed,
 - a. Prior to sentencing,
 - b. Ordered through a Plea in Abeyance, or
 - c. Sentenced after a conviction.
3. For assessments prior to sentencing, the prosecutor will be notified of UCP's acceptance or denial.
4. For assessments after a judge's order, notification is sent when,
 - a. The defendant has completed the assessment and signed the UCP supervision agreement, or
 - b. An issue arises which disqualifies the defendant's participation in UCP.
2. A case management session with Wasatch Behavioral Health is required for,
 - a. An initial treatment assessment, and
 - b. The defendant to sign a Release of Information.
